



Mr. Lorenzo Ravano was appointed by His Serene Highness Prince Albert II on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017, at the Embassy of Monaco in Berlin, which is in charge of bilateral relations with Germany, Austria and Poland. He currently serves as First Counselor, and Deputy Permanent Representative of Monaco to several international Organizations in Vienna (OSCE, UNODC, and UNIDO).

From September 2008 to September 2017, Mr. Ravano served as Deputy Chief of Mission at the Embassy of Monaco in Washington DC, He was notably in charge of maintaining relations with the US State Department, with the Consular network of Monaco in the United States and Canada, and with the Organization of American States.

Prior to these positions, Mr. Ravano has acquired a wide-ranging experience in the Monegasque Government since 1993, and successively served in the Ministry of Public Works and the Ministry of Finance and Economy.

He holds a Degree in Economics, a Bachelor Degree in Business Administration from the International University of Monaco as well as a European Degree in International Marketing delivered by the Academy of Brussels.

He is a Monegasque national. He speaks French, English, Italian and German.
